


SEAMLESS IVANTI SECURE CONNECTION FOR WTO LAPTOPS

1 STEPS TO USE CERTIFICATE-BASED CONNECTION THROUGH IVANTI SECURE

Step-1: Open Ivanti Secure, click '**connect**' on the connection named "**WTO-Cert Remote Connection**".



Open Ivanti Secure, select **WTO-Cert Remote Connection** and click **connect**.

If above fails to connect, select **WTO-User Remote Connection** and click **connect**.


- You will then be connected to the WTO network as if you were in your office. At this stage you will have access to internal IT resources like intranet and outlook without the need of going through Remote Desktop (RDP).
- Local Internet Access: Internet access including WTO internal websites (wto.org, Intranet, docs.wto.org), and DMS will continue to work even when Ivanti is connected.

WTO - Internal

WTO-User-Remote Connection: Is a connection profile that needs user credentials and RSA token and can be used in case of any issue with Certificate based connection.

2 TO MAP NETWORK DRIVES

Step-2: To map the network drives, **double click** on the shortcut available on the Desktop.



This shortcut icon has been installed on all WTO computers.

To make your network drives appear as in the office, double click on this icon.
