1 PRINT BY USB CABLE:

Connect your PC to a printer with a USB cable and Windows automatically will instal printers and drivers.

2 PRINT BY WIFI CONNECTION:

When setting up WiFi printer: make sure Ivanti Secure is not connected otherwise your printer will not be detected

2.1 You need to know the IP address of the home printer.

If not displayed on the printer display, refer to the printer manual.

2.2 You need to install the Wi-Fi personal printer on the WTO laptop.

Connect your PC to the printer with a USB cable and Windows automatically will instal the printer and related drivers.

After that you can start WIFI printer configuration on Windows 10:

- 1. Click Add a printer.
- 2. Click The printer that I want isn't listed.
- 3. On the Add Printer screen, choose Add a Local Printer or network printer with manual settings, then click Next.

- 4. On the Add a Printer/Choose a printer port screen, choose Create a new port.
- 5. From the Type of Port pop-up menu, choose Standard TCP/IP port and click Next.
- In the Hostname or IP address field, enter the IP address of the printer, e.g., 192.168.0.50 Result: The port name will be automatically populated, based on the IP address.
- 7. Click Next.

Result: The Install the printer driver window will display choices.

- 8. Select the printer make from the left-hand column. Then choose the printer model from the right-hand column.
- 9. Click Next.
- 10. On the Type a printer name window, enter a printer name. Then click Next.
- 11. Choose Do not share this printer. Then click Next.
- 12. If desired, select Print a test page.
- 13. Click Finish.

Via WIFI you will be able to print only when Ivanti Secure is disconnected or when is connected as User Remote.
